

Riding events 2010!

Musbury MX Track – Sunday 13.6.10

Starting at 11am, come and ride this MX track with us. It has a stony surface, some mild jumps and a climb/descent. The track can be found at Higher Bruckland Farm, Musbury, Axminster, Devon, EX13 8SU. £15/rider, cash on the day.

Whiteway Barton MX Track – Sunday 20.6.10 & 1.8.10



Starting at approximately 5pm after the race meetings, this is your chance to see how you and your bike perform on a championship MX track. Finishing promptly at 8.30pm, the cost of this event is just £10/rider, payable on the evening.

Hazelwood Farm – Sunday 11.7.10

Starting at midday, this course runs through private farmland and comprises of woodland and fields. Cost of taking part is £15/rider, payable on the day.

Directions: On the A380 approaching Torquay, take the ring road towards Paignton and Brixham. At the end of the dual carriageway turn right and drive past a petrol station. At the top of the hill turn left towards Totnes. In approx 200 yards turn right and follow the TRF signs.

Haccadown Woods – Sunday 22.8.10

Starting at midday, this popular event takes in a course through private woodland. Cost for TRF members is £10/rider (proof of membership required), or £15/rider for non-members, payable on the day.

Directions: If approaching from Exeter/A38/M5, leave the A30 at the Exeter Marsh Barton junction and follow signs for Moretonhampstead, then Pathfinder Village/Tedburn St. Mary at the Swains Garage junction. One mile past White Horse Motors, at the top of the hill, turn left onto the bridge over A30. In 50 yards turn left into the field and follow the TRF signs. If coming from Okehampton, leave the A30 at Fingle Glen, approx. 5 miles west of Exeter. At the roundabout turn right (2nd exit), signed Pathfinder Village. Follow the road past Pathfinder Village and turn right at top of hill onto bridge over A30, then in 50 yards turn left into field and follow the TRF signs. EX6 6AJ or SX844 930 will take you to the field access.

All of our riding events are strictly non-competitive and only road legal, quiet bikes displaying a current tax disc will be admitted to our events preferably with rear trail tyres (road legal knobbles for MX tracks).

! If your day will be spoilt by waiting behind another rider until it is safe to pass, please do not come to our events !
